The Tatamu Table has a robust, solid oak construction, yet is aesthetically light and elegant. Its name comes from the Japanese word meaning 'to fold', with the design influenced by the oblique forms of origami structures. Available in three sizes, to sit 6, 8 and 10 people.

care instructions

Clean with a soft damp cloth and water. Wipe immediately with a dry cloth. Avoid leaving water sitting on the wood as this can cause small spots or permanent marks. Do not use chemical cleaners on any surfaces.

Assembly required. An allen key is required to assemble the table, we recommend two people complete this job together.
