The generous padding of the cushions and the armrests in light or dark solid wood emphasise the inviting appeal of Fauteuil de Salon, whose timeless design vocabulary based on functional requirements lends itself to a wide variety of interiors.

#### Materials

- Seat and backrest: polyurethane filling; cover in fabric or leather.
- Seat height: 415 mm (340 mm with applied load, measured in accordance with EN 1335-1:2000).
- Armrests: solid wood in natural oak with oiled finish, dark stained oak with protective natural lacquer finish, or American walnut with oiled finish.
- **Base:** bent sheet steel and tubular steel, powder-coated (smooth).
- **Glides:** hard glides for carpet or felt glides for hard floors.
- Origin of wood: oak (Quercus robur) from Western Europe and/or Poland; American walnut (Juglans nigra) from the USA.
