








Radial Extendable Table

Lay the table top face down on a soft clean surface. Position the legs matching each numbered leg to the corresponding numbered corner.

Thread a washer and spring washer onto each bolt. Loosely tighten nuts onto each bolt **while holding the table leg flush to the table top**. Fully tighten each bolt to secure the legs.

Always use two people to flip the table over to an upright position. Ensure the table is held by the table top or rails and never the legs when maneuvering.



Note


There are two rails situated on the underside of the table. The extension leaf is designed to be stored on two rails situated on the underside of the tabletop.

It is recommended to use care when installing and removing the leaf as the edge of the tabletop can be damaged during this process.

The tabletop will change colour overtime due to sun exposure. Therefore, there may be some colour difference when the leaf is installed. To avoid this, store the leaf in an exposed environment.


Step 1

- Undo the latches located on the underside of the table.
- Slide the tabletops apart to expose the extension leaf.




Step 2

Gently slide the extension leaf to one side until the end of the leaf is exposed.




Step 3

Carefully remove the leaf from the underside of the tabletop.



Step 4

Gently slide the extension leaf to one side until the end of the leaf is exposed.



Step 5

Lock the latches on the underside of the tabletop.
