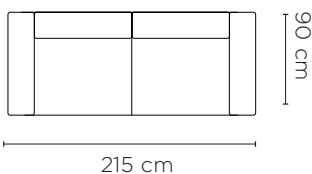

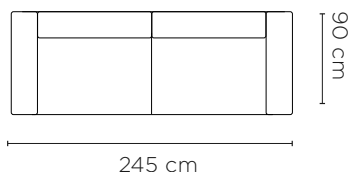

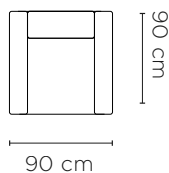
01. 2 Seater



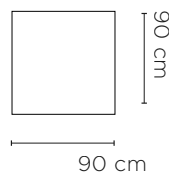
02. 3 Seater



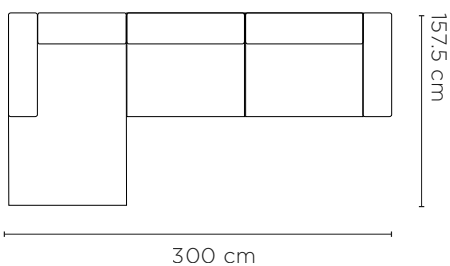
03. Armchair



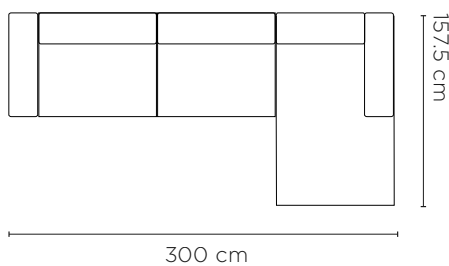

Care Instructions

Avoid direct sunlight. Vacuum regularly using an upholstery attachment on low-suction. All fabric stretches as part of the general wear process. Attend to spills immediately by soaking them up with a clean, absorbent, lint-free sponge or cloth. Gently dab; do not rub vigorously. If cleaning products are required, consult a furniture cleaning specialist. We do not recommend using any fabric protector treatments, as this voids your fabric warranty. Please note, all fabric warranties are with the fabric supplier. Città sofas have a 5-year warranty that covers the frame and fill.

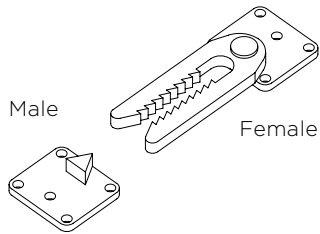

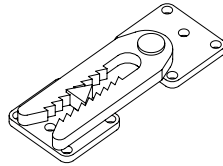
Hem Component Assembly

The Hem sofa is connected using a locking system located on the base of each component. Locking components prevents parts of the sofa from moving around independently.

Lock Disconnected



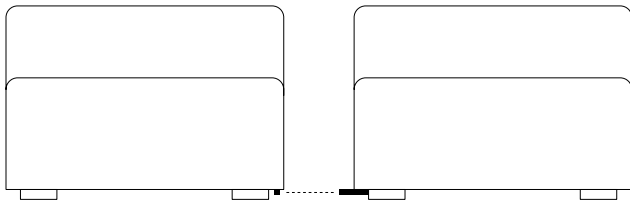
Lock Connected



Step 1

To connect two components, place each unit side by side aligning the male and female part of the lock.

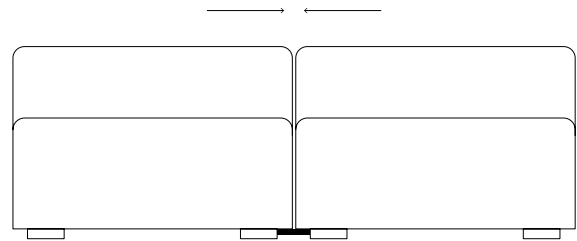
Each component has two male locks and two female locks on opposite sides of the sofa base.

Step 2

Push units together engaging the locking system.

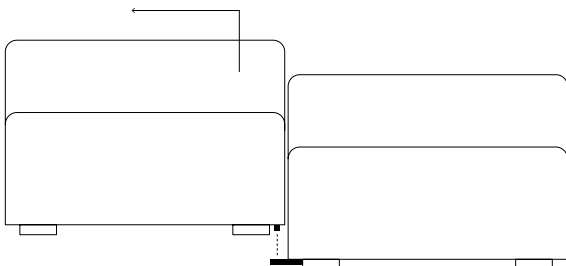


Front View.

Step 3

To separate units, lift up the male part out from female part.

Note: Do not drag the components away from each other to separate.
